



Use of Cloth Face Coverings for Protection Against COVID-19

The Center for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) has recommended that Americans wear cloth face coverings in public to help slow the spread of COVID-19. This recommendation is being made based on studies that show a significant proportion of people with COVID-19 ‘lack symptoms’ and can transmit the virus to others in close proximity, through speaking, coughing, sneezing or other means.

*** Beginning on Monday, May 4th, 2020 ~ Pax will REQUIRE face coverings to be worn in accordance with the Governor’s requirements. Pax will provide three (3) cloth face coverings for you. If preferred ~ it is acceptable for you to wear a different style than provided. Face coverings are now required PPE. You must bring your personal face covering to work every day and wear as required during your work shift.**

Donning Your Face Covering:

- Wash your hands before putting on your face covering.
- Ensure that your nose, mouth and chin are completely covered at all times.
- Face coverings should ***fit snugly but comfortably*** and allow for breathing without restriction.
- DO NOT allow your face covering to slip under your nose and DO NOT unhook ear loops.
- DO NOT touch your covering while you are wearing it ~ If you do, wash your hands immediately.

Removing Your Face Covering:

- DO NOT touch your eyes, nose, or mouth when removing your face covering.
- Wash your hands immediately after removing your face covering.
- Launder / Clean your face covering daily after each use.

Launder / Cleaning Your Face Covering:

- The Pax issued face coverings are machine washable and are re-usable.
- After each daily use, wash your face covering with soap and warm water (by hand or by machine).
- Let air dry completely before wearing the face covering again.

Other Helpful Tips To Help Prevent The Spread of COVID-19:

- For added protection, ALWAYS use face coverings when out in any type of public settings.
 - Always maintain 6 feet social distancing (when possible) even when you are wearing a covering.
