



## **When To Use Face Shields**

The intent of the face shields is to help protect individuals at Pax when they may be unable to maintain a social distance of 6 feet. This does not mean that when using the face shields, they can be standing right next to each other if they are able to adequately perform their job at a further distance. Face coverings are not to be removed, but rather are to worn in conjunction with your face shield. The following are some examples of situations where using a face shield is to be used:

- Die service technician working on a die in the pressroom with an additional die service technician or press operator assisting them at a distance less than 6 feet.
- QA technician instructing a press operator or secondary operator on how to complete their measurement checks when they are less than 6 feet from each other.
- Maintenance technicians working together less than 6 feet apart from each other.
- Any situation in which two individuals are less than 6 feet apart from each other.

Prior to using your face shield, please wipe down the bracket that goes around your head along with the thin plastic film in front of your face with a paper towel that is damp with Isopropyl alcohol.

This policy shall remain in effect while the Company's social distancing requirements are in place.
